## **The Dump Comes to You:**

Dumpster Day is a free annual event that brings a small fleet of dumpsters for residents to discard large items, exercise equipment, furniture, mattresses, etc. on Saturday morning between 8 a.m. and noon. It's a great day to get rid of old fencing, couches, broken toys, and items that didn't sell at your last garage sale. What we can't take has changed a little this year:

**Not Permitted:** a/c units, appliances (refrigerators, microwaves, etc), auto parts or tires, construction waste (dirt, drywall, concrete etc), glass or mirrors, tree trunks, hazardous waste (fluorescent bulbs, paint, propane, batteries, chemicals), machinery like copiers or oversized items like pianos or swingsets. Do your trimming and teardowns before the 14th because the dumpsters fill up fast and are gone by noon. This year we have five dumpsters spread throughout Washington Square, courtesy of your Neighborhood Association, the City of Santa Ana and Republic Services, so bring it out!

## **eWaste:**

Working and non-working electronics you want to get rid of are welcome. Again this year we have an eWaste truck hosted by the Lutz's at 1118 N. Freeman. So if it has a cord, bring it for recycling. This includes computers, microwaves, video games, printers, fax machines, TV's, radios, CD players, DVD players, small household appliances & car batteries. For TV's and computer monitors, you must attach a note with your name, address and phone number per State of CA requirements. They don't accept non-rechargeable batteries, large appliances or light bulbs.

Each friendly volunteer Dumpster Monitor is responsible for verifying your residence in Washington Square (so bring ID), and monitoring dumpster contents.
